RULES

- 1) This contest is open to all, Malaysian and non-Malaysian participants.
- 2) Photograph for each Category must be of a WILD BIRD of Borneo. There will be Two Categories (i) Stills , and (ii) Video.
- 3) Photographs of bird nesting will be disqualified.
- 4) Photos must be taken between 27th October 2019 to 21st October 2022.
- 5) The photographs must be a single work of original material taken by the contest entrant only.
- 6) Each Entry may submit a maximum of 2 photos or video, and must be identified and captioned.
- 7) Entries must be taken in digital format.
- 8) For Judging purpose, file size requirement for Stills entry in Low-Resolution JPG at least 3MB & Video entry at least 10 seconds only.
- 9) Winning Entries must submit high resolution at least 300dpi with 5MB file size.
- 10) All entries must show original RAW or JPG image file, with Date and Time of capture or EXIF data.
- 11) Optimization of images, colour contrast, brightness, sharpening and cropping is acceptable.
- 12) The entries are non-returnable.
- 13) Photographers retain the copyright to their images, by entering them into this contest, they permit or allow the Borneo Bird Festival (BBF) organisers the usage of their photograph/s to promote the Borneo Bird Festival event in all types of media, printed or online. Photo Credit will be acknowledged, without fee or compensation.
- 14) The organizers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to an entry.
- 15) Judging of Contest consists of one (1) round of evaluation. A panel of Wildlife Photographers and Bird experts will evaluate all eligible entries based on the following Judging Criteria:
(a) Photographic quality: Sharpness (b) Composition (c) Unique behavior / Endemism
