ELIGIBILITY

Each team must consist of TWO (2) participants. **NEW**

Requirements:

- At least one (1) member possess basic bird identification skills.
- Each team must appoint one team leader.
- Participants must be physically fit to undertake walking on forest trails and uneven terrain.

RACE RULES

Bird Identification Rules

- Every species recorded must be supported by a clear photograph. **NEW**
- Both team members must agree on each identification.
- The Race Arbitrators reserve the right to reject unclear records.

Ethical Birding

Participants shall

- Respect wildlife and habitats.
- Avoid disturbing nests or breeding birds.
- Refrain from playback of bird calls.
- Remain on designated trails.
- Respect local communities and private property.

Recording

Participants must record :

- Species
- Time observed
- Location
- Photograph [1 specie 1 photo]

The completed logbook and photographs (jpeg) must be submitted by 8.00 AM on Sunday, 8 November 2026.



SCORING

- One (1) point is awarded for every confirmed species.
- Bonus points may be awarded for selected endemic or rare species listed by the Race Committee.
- In the event of a tie, ranking will be determined by :
 - Highest number of endemic species
 - Earliest complete submission
 - Decision of the Chief Race Arbitrator

HEALTH & SAFETY

Participants are responsible for their own health and wellbeing.

Please:

- Wear appropriate outdoor clothing and footwear.
- Carry sufficient drinking water.
- Bring insect repellent, sun protection and rain gear.
- Carry your own binoculars, camera and field equipment.
- Inform the organisers of any medical conditions before the race.
- Save emergency contact numbers in your mobile phone.
- If severe weather or unsafe conditions occur, participants must immediately leave the trails and follow instructions issued by race officials.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Participants are expected to

- Demonstrate honesty and integrity.
- Respect fellow competitors.
- Follow all instructions from race officials.
- Protect the natural environment.
- Promote positive sportsmanship throughout the event.
- Failure to comply with race rules may result in penalties or disqualification.
